Petitioner had challenged her termination way back in the year 2009. She earlier served a legal notice, which has been decided vide order dated 2.5.2018. It has been stated therein that contractual service of the petitioner came to an end on 28.12.2009. She posed no challenge to same. Her claim was, therefore, misconceived. I find no infirmity with the order. Petition is without merit and is hereby dismissed. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that provident fund of the petitioner has not been released. She shall be at liberty to represent to the concerned department in this respect.
