The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.13 dated 24.02.2019, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 325, 326, 427, 506, 120-B, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Rawalpindi Phagwara, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had caused a number of injuries to the complainant with sword. He also contends that the petitioner is 22 years of age and is in custody for over six months. The petitioner is not involved in any other case and the injured has fully recovered from the injuries.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Manjit Singh, states that the petitioner is the main accused but none of the 30 witnesses has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is 22 years old and is in custody for over

six months, he is not involved in any other case, the complainant has fully recovered from the injuries and trial is likely to take sometime, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
