Prayer in the present petition is to grant regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 65 dated 22.5.2019 registered under Sections 417, 420, 188, 120-B IPC and Section 66D of IT Act at Police Station Sector 20, Panchkula and subsequent charges under Sections 417, 420, 188, 511, 120-B IPC and Section 66-D of IT Act (framed vide order dated 1.8.2019 passed by JMIC, Panchkula).

Case is triable by a Magistrate. As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner was found committing cheating while appearing in the entrance examination.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Gulab Singh submits that petitioner is in custody since 22.4.2019.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the facts that investigations against the petitioner are complete and conclusion of trial is likely to take some time, in the considered view of the

Court, petitioner deserves the concession of bail and therefore, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail. However, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is a resident of Uttar Pradesh, he be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds with one local surety of equal amount, to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate,

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
