The present appeal is filed for enhancement of compensation as granted vide award dated 22.04.2014 passed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Chandigarh (for short, the Tribunal), vide which, an amount of ₹1,01,353/- was granted.

Learned counsel for the appellant while praying for enhancement of compensation submitted that nothing much has been given towards transportation, special diet, hospitalization and attendant charges etc.

Heard.

A perusal of the award shows that the permanent disability in the present case was 18% of right limb, an amount of ₹27,000/- i.e. ₹2,000/- per percentage of disability has already been awarded and an amount of ₹30,353/- has also been awarded for the expenditure on medicines/treatment. A total amount of ₹1,01,353/- was awarded alongwith

interest way back in the year 2014, for an accident, which occurred on

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12.12.2010. The driver of the offending vehicle had already been proceeded against ex parte. Hence, no ground is made out to enhance the compensation as awarded by the Tribunal under any of the heads and the compensation so awarded is fair and just in the circumstances.

Dismissed accordingly.
