This application under Section 151 CPC has been moved at the instance of applicant-respondent No.3/Insurance Company for disposal of instant appeal in view of compromise as arrived at between appellant/claimant and respondent No.3/Insurance Company, in terms of which, respondent No.3/Insurance Company shall make payment of ₹60,000/- (Rupees Sixty thousand only) over and above the awarded amount as per Award dated 29.09.2015 rendered by the Tribunal.

In view of above, as appellant/claimant as well as respondent No.3/Insurance Company are in agreement to above said compromise, instant application is allowed.

CM is disposed of.

Main Case

In view of above, instant appeal is disposed of in the manner that respondent No.3/Insurance Company shall pay/deposit a sum of ₹60,000/- (Rupees Sixty thousand only) favouring appellant/claimant (Gulzari Lal) as compensation in the shape of Demand Draft before the Tribunal concerned, within four (4) weeks from today, failing which, respondent No.3/Insurance Company shall be liable to pay above said amount of ₹60,000/- along with interest @ 9% per annum, from the date of institution of instant appeal till payment/deposit thereof in favour of appellant/claimant.

Disposed of accordingly.
