This is petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 69, dated 2.5.2019, registered under Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Sadar Nabha, District Patiala.

As per allegations in FIR, 440 bottles of illicit liquor make Santra Rasila, meant for sale in Haryana, were recovered from the dicky of car of petitioner.

The learned counsel for petitioner contends that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case.

Vide order dated 30.8.2019, this Court, while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail, directed petitioner to join investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Panjab Singh, states that petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of above, petition is allowed. The order dated 30.8.2019, granting interim anticipatory bail to petitioner, is made absolute. However, petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
