Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.53 dated 07.04.2019 under Sections 406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Urban Estate, Patiala.

While granting interim bail to petitioners No.2 & 3, following order was passed by this Court on 27.09.2019: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioners, after arguing the case for some time and finding that this Court is not convinced qua petitioner No.1 Kamaljit Kaur, submits that the anticipatory bail qua her may be dismissed as withdrawn.

Ordered accordingly.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that petitioner No.2 Shamsher Kaur is aged about 80 years, who is

mother of co-accused Navjot Singh and petitioner No.3 Lovepreet Kaur is unmarried daughter, aged about 26 years, of Navjot Singh and there are no specifics allegation against them in the FIR...”

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Pardeep Kumar, submits that petitioners No.2 & 3 have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to petitioners No.2 & 3 vide order dated 27.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C., as the petition qua petitioner No.1 already stands dismissed as withdrawn.
