In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.70 dated 02.03.2019, under Sections 22 and 29 of Narcotics Drug Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Pataudi, District Gurugram.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that as per the reports of Regional Forensic Science Laboratory, Bhondsi (Gurugram), Haryana and Central Forensic Science Laboratory, Sector 36-A, Chandigarh none of the narcotic drug and psychotropic substances could be detected.

3. Learned State counsel is not in a position to deny this fact.

4. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

5. In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, having regard to the fact that disposal of the trial will take sufficient time, I

deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

6. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner-Vikas is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.

7. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

8. Petition stands allowed.
