HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.190, dated 30.11.2017, registered under Sections 279, 337, 338, 427 IPC, at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiapur and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise effected between the parties (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 30.08.2019, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Area Judicial Magistrate for recording their statements and the trial Court/Area Judicial Magistrate was to send its report regarding the genuineness of compromise.

Report dated 16.10.2019 has been received from the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Dasuya, according to which, the

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statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any pressure or coercion. None of the accused has been declared as Proclaimed Offender.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and FIR No.190, dated 30.11.2017, registered under Sections 279, 337, 338, 427 IPC, at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiapur (P-1) along with all consequential proceedings having arisen therefrom, is quashed qua the petitioner.
