GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner/NISA Education *inter alia* to quash the letter dated 21.09.2018 (Annexure P-7), to that extent, where the respondent have failed to issue the extension of their recommendation for academic session 2018-19.

During pendency of the present writ petition, an affidavit dated 27.03.2019, has been filed by the Additional Director of Director Elementary Education, Haryana, Panchkula. In Para 14 of the reply, it has been mentioned that the petitioner-Association is claiming affiliation with the Board of School Education, Haryana for the Academic Session 2018-19 and the present petition has become infructuous as Board exams of Session 2018-19 has already been conducted in the State of Haryana and their Session is going to expire on 31.03.2019. For ready reference, Para-14 of

the reply, is reproduced as under:-

*“That it is pertinent to mention here that the petitioner association is claiming affiliation with the Board of School Education Haryana for the academic session 2018-19. The present writ petition has become infructuous as the Board exams of the session 2018-19 has already been conducted in the State of Haryana and this session is going to expire on 31.03.2019. In compliance of the order dated 18.03.2019 of the Hon'ble High Court passed in the aforementioned PILs, the department/respondents is going to decide the cases of the recognition of the schools like petitioner and a final action taken report will be filed accordingly on or before **03.04.2019**. Thus, the cases of the member schools of the petitioner association will also be decided on the same line of action, which is under progress.”*

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.

No further orders are called for.
