On the last date of hearing i.e. 09.01.2019, the following order
was passed:-

*“Counsel for the State informs the Court that the demarcation
has been carried out by the Tehsildar, Samana and the report
would be submitted in this Court within a period of one week.
Mr. G.S.Attariwala, Advocate, has filed his Vakalatnama on
behalf of respondents No. 6 and 7 and he, on instructions from
Sh. Baljinder Singh, Executive Officer, Nagar Council,
Samana, District Patiala respondent No. 7, states that none of
the employees of the Nagar Council, Samana shall enter the*

land of the petitioners.

Counsel for the petitioners prays that some time may be given to verify this aspect and see the conduct of the Nagar Council. Hearing of the case is deferred to 12.02.2019, to see the correctness or otherwise of the statement made by respondent No. 7 in Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners has sought instructions from the petitioners and states that in the light of the statement of counsel for respondent Nos.6 and 7, as recorded in the order reproduced above, he would not press the present petition, provided they are bound by the said statement.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as not pressed. However, respondent Nos.6 and 7 shall be bound by the statement as recorded in the order dated 09.01.2019.
