The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 82 dated 22.10.2017, registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala.

On 02.09.2019, the following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners were granted bail by the trial Court, however, on account of noting the wrong date, they absented from the Court proceedings on 23.04.2019 and they bail/surety bonds were cancelled. It is further submitted that the petitioners are ready to surrender before the trial Court on 03.09.2019.

Notice of motion for 23.09.2019.

In the meantime, the petitioners are directed to appear before the trial Court on 03.09.2019 and the trial Court will release them on interim bail subject to their furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds and on payment of costs of Rs.3,000/- each, to be deposited with the District Legal Services Authority, concerned.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 02.09.2019, have already appeared before the trial Court and they have been released on interim bail and the petitioners have also deposited the cost with the District Legal Services Authority, concerned.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Harbans Singh, has not disputed the factual position.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order dated 02.09.2019 is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
