Petitioner has prayed for a mandamus to direct the respondents No.2 & 3 to strictly comply with the guidelines contained in letter dated 16.01.2017 (Annexure P-3) while making recruitment to the posts of Craft Instructors.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that the matter shall be considered by the competent authority within three weeks from today and appropriate decision shall be taken. In case it is felt that any of the guidelines issued by NCVT need to be incorporated, appropriate steps shall be taken. Needless to observe, if same are not applicable, respondents shall be at liberty to proceed further with the recruitment.

In view of above, no further direction is necessary.
