Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.14 dated 10.03.2017 registered under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Mattewal, District Amritsar.

It is undisputed that the petitioner was released on bail but thereafter, he jumped the bail. He applied for anticipatory bail before the learned Additional Sessions Judge and the learned Judge after considering the facts of the case, granted opportunity to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and on surrender, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing fresh bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety. The petitioner in spite of opportunity having been granted, did not choose to appear. In such circumstances, learned Additional Sessions Judge dismissed the bail application.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is suffering from spine disease and therefore, he could not surrender before

the trial Court.

In the considered view of this Court, the petitioner was aware of his circumstances when he applied for pre-arrest bail and the Court granted indulgence to him on 23.07.2019. Once the opportunity has been granted to the petitioner and he has failed to avail the same, this Court does not find any reason to grant indulgence once again.

Hence the petition is dismissed.
