Both the aforementioned appeals shall stand decided by this
common order as the award and issue is identical.

Both the appeals have been filed for enhancement of
compensation granted vide award dated 11.12.2013, passed by the Motor
Accident Claims Tribunal, Nuh (for short, the Tribunal).

FAO No.4815 of 2014 and another connected case

Learned counsel appearing for the appellant while praying for enhancement submitted that the amount awarded is on the lower side. Further, no amount has been granted towards attendant charges, transportation, diet and nutrition etc.

Taking into account the same, this Court deems it appropriate to enhance the compensation by granting a lump sum amount of Rs.15,000/- in FAO-4815-2014 and Rs.30,000/- in FAO-4885-2014.

Thus, the enhanced amount be paid to the appellant, within two months from the receipt of certified copy of this order alongwith 6% interest per annum from the date of filing of claim petition till its realization.

In case the said amount is not paid within two months, the same shall be paid thereafter alongwith 12% interest from the expiry of the period of two months.

Both the appeals are disposed of accordingly.
