In compliance with the order dated 03.07.2019 passed by this Court, compliance report by way of affidavit of Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Budhlada-respondent No.4 has been filed today in Court.

In paras 4 and 5 of the said affidavit, it has been stated as under:-

“That in due compliance with the above directions issued vide order dated 3.7.2019, it is most respectfully submitted that the remaining work of laying down underground 4 feet deep and 15 feet long pipeline through the land of the petitioner to the land of the Gram Panchayat bearing Khasra No.186 has been completed in the presence of petitioner and other respectable of the village and officials, after getting approval from the

Deputy Commissioner, Mansa. It is pertinent to mention here that no objection was raised by the petitioner at the time of completing of this remaining work of laying down the pipe lines in his field. It is further relevant to mention here that no water tanks have been constructed on the land of the petitioner and no dirty water enters in the field of the petitioner, the path, where the pipes have been laid has been leveled so that users of the path may not face any difficulty or inconvenience. Copies of photographs taken at the site are attached herewith as Annexure R-1.

5. That from the above, it is crystal clear that the deponent by laying down the 4 feet pipe line in the field of petitioner, leveling the path where the pipe lines has been laid without any protest, has complied with the directions of this Hon'ble High Court.”

In the light of the above in the opinion of this Court, the interest of the petitioner has been taken care of. However, the respondents shall ensure that after the digging of pipes, let there be proper levelling of the path so that the users should not be put to any inconvenience. An arrangement with regard to disposal of waste water, which has been resorted to by the respondents, shall continue.

In view of the above, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
