GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.361, dated 21.7.2018, registered at Police Station Thanesar Sadar, District Kurukshetra, under Sections 323, 498-A, 365 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 365 IPC deleted later on, Section 75 of Juvenile Justice Act and Section 406 IPC added later on) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise effected between the parties.
2. Mr. Arav Gupta, Advocate has appeared on behalf of respondent No.2 and filed power of attorney. The same is taken on record.
3. Vide order dated 30.8.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

4. Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kurukshetra, has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of petitioners/accused Piyush Goel, Vinod Goel and also of complainant Shalini Gupta have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.
5. The complainant in her statement has specifically stated that she has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
6. The learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kurukshetra, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.
7. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (CrL) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.361, dated 21.7.2018, registered at Police Station Thanesar Sadar, District Kurukshetra, under Sections 323, 498-A, 365 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 365 IPC deleted later on) and Section 75 of Juvenile Justice Act (Section 406 IPC added later on) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
