Petitioner-society i.e. the Gurdwara Shri Guru Granth Sahib Welfare Society, V.P.O., Khanowal, District Kapurthala has filed the instant petition seeking a Mandamus to direct the official respondents to take necessary measures for protecting the property which is stated to be under the ownership and possession of the petitioner-society.

Pleadings on record would indicate that the petitioner society has already availed of its civil remedy in terms of instituting a suit for permanent injunction and in which respondent no.6 herein has been arrayed as a party/defendant. Furthermore, an application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC was also filed and which was disposed of vide order dated 1.7.2019 passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Kapurthala granting status quo.

Since civil proceedings in relation to the property in question are already pending final adjudication, this Court would not enter into such dispute.

The instant writ petition is only seen as an attempt by the petitioner society as parallel proceedings and which this Court observes to be not maintainable.

Petition is dismissed.
