Grievance of the petitioner is that he has not been extended the benefit of pension as per the old pension scheme despite the fact that their case is squarely covered by judgment titled as **Harbans Lal Vs. The State of Punjab and others** (CWP-2371-2010 decided on 31.08.2010).

2.) The petitioner caused issuance of legal notice dated 20.05.2019 (Annexure P-9) but the same was not adverted to by the respondents. Hence, the writ petition.

3.) Notice of motion.

4.) On advance service of copy of the petition, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Senior Advocate assisted by Ms. Ambika Bedi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, appears on behalf of respondents-State of Punjab.

- 5.) Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.
- 6.) Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the legal notice dated 20.05.2019 (Annexure P-9) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in this petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.
- 7.) Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
- 8.) Disposed of in above terms.
