The petitioner filed CRM-M-No.23180 of 2019 seeking direction to Superintendent of Police, Panipat to decide the representation dated 29.3.2019. The petition was disposed of on 20.5.2019, the Superintendent of Police, Panipat, was directed to decide the representation dated 29.3.2019 and also to ensure that the petitioner is not harassed, in any manner, more particularly in respect of cases in which he is a prosecution witness.

The present petition has been filed pleading that needful is not done by the respondent.

Reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Sumit Kumar, HPS, Superintendent of Police, Panipat, dated 23.11.2019 filed today in Court, is taken on record and copy supplied to counsel for petitioner. Alongwith the reply order dated 11.11.2019 is annexed whereby the representation of the petitioner is decided.

Learned State counsel submits that after the petitioner was attacked, five police officials have been deputed by Police since March 2015 and the security of the petitioner is being continuously monitored by security agent deputed in Police Station Sanoli. It is further submitted that grievance of petitioner with regard to proceedings under Section 182 Cr.P.C., no longer exist as these are pending in Court and are fixed for 30.11.2019. It is further submitted that the persons who attacked the petitioner was identified and FIR No. 248 dated 16.11.2019 under Section 323, 506 IPC has been registered at Police Station Sanoli. He further submits that the orders of this Court has been complied with.

In view of submission made by State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law in case cause of action still survives or arises in future.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for.
