[1] Learned counsel states that the petitioners have submitted a representation (Annexure P-1) to the respondents for correction of their date of birth as recorded with the Employees Provident Fund Organization but that no decision has been taken in respect thereto, till date.

[2] A perusal of the representation (Annexure P-1) reveals that the same is dated 02.08.2019, whereas the writ petition is dated 07.08.2019 and a direction is sought to the respondents to decide the representation (Annexure P-1).

[3] To my mind, the writ petition is wholly pre-mature, as the representation (Annexure P-1), dated 02.08.2019 was submitted by the petitioners to respondent No.1 only on 02.08.2019 and without waiting for a decision on the same, the petitioners have filed a writ petition on 07.08.2019.

[4] In the circumstances, the writ petition is ***disposed of***, by granting liberty to the petitioners to pursue the matter with respondent No.1 for decision on the representation (Annexure P-1), dated 02.08.2019.
