The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 156 dated 07.08.2019, under Sections 147, 149, 452, 323 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Dhauj, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is the counter-blast to the FIR lodged by the petitioners, as the accused therein had misbehaved with them. He also contends that the petitioners are ladies and only simple injuries are alleged to have been caused by them.

This Court, by the order dated 30.08.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sunil Kumar, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 30.08.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
