Prayer made in this writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is inter alia for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent-bank to restructure balance loan amount for the next seven years to the tune of ₹37,17,765/- alongwith future interest which may be decided by the Hon'ble Court out of the total ₹58,45,000/- sanctioned by the respondent-bank in favour of the petitioner in 13.08.2014 (Annexure P-1) as the respondent-bank had failed to discharge its liability qua the timely disbursal of the loan amount to the petitioner due to which the petitioner suffered grave and unwanted loss in his business.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that talks of amicable settlement with the bank are in progress. Accordingly, prayer was made that she may be allowed to withdraw the present petition. Further prayer was also made that liberty be granted to the petitioner to approach this Court again in case talks of compromise do not materialize.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It is, however, clarified that it shall be open for the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be, available to him, in accordance with law in the event of failure of settlement talks between the petitioner and the respondent-bank.
