[1] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has filed representations Annexure P-4 dated 12.06.2019 and Annexure P-5 dated 04.07.2019 in respect of the grievances which are the subject matter of the instant writ petition but that no decision has been taken on the same till date.

[2] Learned counsel further states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the said representations Annexure P-4 and Annexure P-5 dated 12.06.2019 and 04.07.2019 respectively as expeditiously as possible.

[3] Notice of motion to contesting respondent No.1 only.

[4] Mr. Parveen Mehta, Advocate, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1. Copy of the writ petition has been supplied to learned counsel and on perusal thereof learned counsel states that he has no objection to the innocuous nature of the prayer made by learned

counsel for the petitioner for directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the representations Annexures P-4 and P-5 dated 12.06.2019 and 04.07.2019 in accordance with law.

[5] In view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the representations Annexure P-4 dated 12.06.2019 and Annexure P-5 dated 04.07.2019 respectively in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
