Petitioner has filed the instant petition seeking a mandamus to direct the official respondents to take necessary steps to protect his life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.6 to 8.

Further directions are sought even with regard to protection of the property of the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length.

Pleadings on record are wholly insufficient for this Court to infer any imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Insofar as protection of property is concerned the conceded position is that civil proceedings already stands initiated in regard thereto and in which petitioner as also private respondents are parties.

Apparently, the instant writ petition is merely a fallout of the civil litigation that is being fought between the parties.

No intervention in the matter is called for.

Petition dismissed.
