MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J. (Oral)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.100 dated 22.03.2019 (P-1), under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (*for short 'IPC'*) (Sections 326 & 120-B, IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 30.08.2019, passed the following order:-

“ Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that neither the petitioner was named in the FIR, nor any injury has been attributed to him. Further contends that one of co-accused namely Happy has already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail vide order dated 24.07.2019 passed by this Court.

Notice of motion for 11.09.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of

his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Contents that in terms of above order, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from S.I. Gurmukh Singh, has acknowledged that in terms of order dated 30.08.2019, petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, interim order dated 30.08.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is also made clear that petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

Disposed off accordingly.
