The instant writ petition was directed against the order dated 3.1.2017 (Annexure P-2) and whereby the petitioner while serving on the post of Superintendent, Town Improvement Trust, Amritsar was transferred to Town Improvement Trust, Bathinda against a vacant post of Superintendent.

While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court on 13.1.2017:-

“It is contended that the petitioner has been transferred from his place of posting at Amritsar as Superintendent, Improvement Trust, Amritsar to Bathinda vide impugned order dated 4.1.2017, however, by that time Model Code of Conduct stood notified and the petitioner has been assigned Election duty.

Notice of motion for 30.3.2017.

Till the next date of hearing, transfer order of petitioner from Amritsar to Bathinda shall remain stayed.”

Learned State counsel informs the Court that the petitioner attained the age of superannuation on 31.12.2017.

In view of the above, nothing would survive in the instant writ petition.

Writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
