This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant all the benefits to the petitioner which are being given to the disabled and handicapped employees, with immediate effect and also the petitioner be considered in the DPC meeting for the promotion to the post of Deputy Director, Employment Generation and Training.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner got promoted to the post of Deputy Director, Employment Generation and Training, however, he is not offered appointment from the date of availability of vacancy.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case and considering the fact that the principal relief has been allowed to the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to represent before the Department regarding the date of appointment, if so advised, in accordance with law. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the request made by the petitioner is admissible, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of eight weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the request made by the petitioner is not admissible, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
