The petitioner was posted at Jhajjar on 19.01.2014 and he has prayed for setting aside the order dated 2.2.2018 (Annexure P-14) whereby he has been transferred from Jhajjar to Panchkula.

When notice of motion was issued by this Court on 12.02.2018, operation of the impugned order was stayed.

As of today, the petitioner has completed five years of service in Jhajjar.

As per the reply filed by the respondents-State, the petitioner is now continuing the work at Jhajjar for more than 03 years. Further the respondents have given details of four complaints which are pending against the petitioner. The Deputy Commissioner, Jhajjar has recommended the disciplinary proceedings against the petitioner vide letter dated 19.01.2018 (Annexure R1). As per order dated 19.05.2017 (Annexure R2) his temporary headquarter was shifted to Dabawali and vide order dated 31.08.2017 (Anexure R3) again his temporary headquarter was shifted to Loharu Courts. The respondents have also annexed Annexures R-4 and R-5,

whereby warning has been given to the petitioner and one Ms. Sonu Choudhary for making complaints against each other.

Keeping in view fact that the petitioner is facing complaints and he has completed three years of service, no ground is made out for setting aside the order dated 2.2.2018 (Annexure P-14).

The writ petition is being dismissed.
