Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.44 dated 12.05.2019 registered under Sections 325, 324, 323, 148, 149, 447, 511 IPC (Sections 326 and 307 of IPC added later on), at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur.

Heard.

On 02.09.2019, the following order was passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court:

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.44 dated 12.05.2019 registered under Sections 325, 324, 323, 148, 149, 447, 511 of the Indian Penal Code (Sections 326 and 307 of IPC added later on), at Police

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Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is 67 years old and the injury under Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code is not attributed to the petitioner. It has further been contended that the petitioner, as per the case of the prosecution, is alleged to have given injury on both the legs with iron rod.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. S.P.S. Tinna, Addl. AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab. A copy of the paper book be handed over to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Adjourned to 23.10.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 02.09.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and he is not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 02.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject

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to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
