Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner for correction of date of birth to read as 06.01.1992 in the Middle and Secondary Certificate against the wrongly mentioned date of 10.2.1991 in the said certificates.

2. Learned counsel states that despite the petitioner having made representation Annexure P-4 dated 3.7.2019, no decision has been taken in respect thereto till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if at this stage, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide representation Annexure P-4 dated 3.7.2019 in a time bound manner.

3. In view of the innocuous nature of the prayer, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide representation Annexure P-4 dated 3.7.2019 as per rules and regulations applicable.

4. Writ petition is disposed of with the aforementioned directions.
