Petitioner Thomas by way of this invocation under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has prayed for grant of interim regular bail in case bearing FIR No.24 dated 17.02.2018 under Sections 302/341/427/354/506/379-B/188/148/149/120-B IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act pertaining to Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur to attend marriage of his sister.

Upon notice, learned State counsel assisted by ASI Dilbag Singh, Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur, has placed on record report of the concerned Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur dated 11.09.2019 along with the supporting documents and the marriage invitation card, whereby after recording statements of the respectables of the village, it has been reported that marriage of Roma, real sister of the

petitioner, is to be solemnized on 16.09.2019 with Jobanpreet Singh son of Sh.Manjit Singh, resident of village Ghuddu Wala.

In the light of contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner that presence of the petitioner being real brother of the bride, is very much essential at the ceremony as per the rituals and customs prevalent, which is not refuted on behalf of the State. Having regard to these circumstances, it would sub-serve the ends of justice if the petitioner is released on interim regular bail for a period of two days with effect from 16th Sept. 2019 subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹3.00 lacs and two sureties in the like amount each to the satisfaction of Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Ferozepur and the petitioner shall surrender before the Superintendent, Central Jail, Ferozepur on 18.09.2019 at 10.00 a.m.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
