ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 345 dated 11.07.2018, under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Dharuhera, District Rewari.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR against the petitioner are that he while obtaining a loan of Rs.3,00,000/- under the 'Kisan Credit Scheme' had mortgaged his share of the land, which was found to be less than the share he had projected. He, however, contends that the share, which the petitioner has, is sufficient to return the loan amount.

This Court, by the order dated 02.09.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released

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on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer,
subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bhagwan Dass,
states that although the petitioner has joined investigation the money has to
be recovered.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner
and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the
order dated 02.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made
absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated
under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when
called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
