The writ petition was filed by the petitioner seeking directions to the respondents to release the revised pensionary benefits. The writ petition was disposed of on 10.4.2019 directing the respondent to decide the legal notice dated 20.8.2018. The needful was to be done within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 are invoked pleading that needful has not been done.

Reply was filed by the respondent pleading that decision on the legal notice has been taken and the amounts due already paid to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for petitioner raises a grievance that issue with regard to interest on the delayed payment as claimed in the legal notice has

not been decided by the respondent.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that a reasoned order would be passed within six weeks from today with regard to the claim of interest on the delayed amount.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of.
