This is 3rd petition for grant of regular bail in FIR No.106 dated 15.07.2017 under Sections 302, 148, 149, 120-B IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

Affidavit of Inspector Mukhtiar Singh, Incharge, Malkhana (NDPS), DPO Faridkot filed in the Court today, is taken on record and copy of the same has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, submits that out of total 22 prosecution witnesses, 17 PWs have been examined and even the complainant has supported the prosecution version.
