Today at the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to approach the trial Court for grant of regular bail.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to approach the trial Court so as to seek regular bail. In case, the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within one week from today and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the trial Court shall endeavour to decide the same expeditiously preferably within a period of two days from filing of such application, while taking into account the fact that co-accused of the petitioner i.e. petitioner's

husband has already been acquitted wherein the complainant has resiled from her earlier statement and has virtually denied the entire occurrence.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
