Petitioner Nitin has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No. 49 dated 20.02.2019, under Section 379-A IPC registered at Police Station Yamunanagar Sadar, District Yamunanagar.

The FIR was registered on the complaint made by Ashish Kumar who stated that on 17.02.2019 at around 10 PM he took bus from Chandigarh to Yamunanagar. At 2 AM, he was at Kherada bye-pass and he started walking towards Yamunanagar. After some time, two boys came and snatched his camera, two mobile phones and ran away.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner was indicted on the basis of disclosure statement dated 24.3.2019 suffered by the co-accused Sagar @ Amit. He submitted that said accused Sagar @ Amit has also been granted bail vide order dated 31.7.2019 by trial Court. He submits that investigation is complete and final report stands submitted.

Considering the above and custody of the petitioner, this Court does not find any valid reason for further detention of the petitioner in judicial custody. Resultantly, without meaning any expression of opinion on the merits of the case, it is ordered that the petitioner be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing the requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition is allowed.
