Present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.124 dated 26.04.2019, under Section 120-B, 406, 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Kanina, District Mahendergarh.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contended that complainant of this case, in fact, is the accused of the case and he has received the amount and the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case, so he be granted the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Learned State counsel contended that during investigation, it has come that the present petitioner alongwith complainant of the matter has received Rs.9,00,000/- from Munshi Ram and another Rs.12,00,000/- from Om Parkash and the matter required intensive investigation.

Having considered the above facts and taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner would be required for effective investigation of the matter, no case is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the present petition is dismissed.
