Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.120 dated 13.06.2018 under Sections 363, 366 IPC (the offence punishable under Section 346 IPC has been deleted), registered at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that in the whole FIR, there is no allegation against the petitioner and it is only on the basis of supplementary statement made on 15.03.2019, there are some allegations against the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

In the aforesaid FIR, admittedly the matter is under investigation and after initial version, the complainant has made the supplementary statement alleging therein that the petitioner has taken away

his wife Neha with an intention to solemnize marriage. Once, the matter is under investigation, no interference at this stage is called for.

Dismissed.
