AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rakesh Kumar, who is present in Court to assist him, submits that the petitioners in these petitions have joined investigation, pursuant to the order dated 02.09.2019 (in CRM-M-36260-2019) and 20.09.2019 (in CRM-M-38546-2019), and presently their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, the interim orders dated 02.09.2019 (in CRM-M-36260-2019) and 20.09.2019 (in CRM-M-38546-2019), passed by this Court, are made absolute, on the same terms and conditions.

However, this order will not be treated to be an observation of this court on the merits of the case, but only in view of the fact that the investigating agency itself has stated that it does not require custodial interrogation of the petitioners.
