Upon notice of motion having been issued, learned State counsel as also counsel for the complainant have appeared, with learned State counsel stating on instructions from SI Manish Kumar, that as a matter of fact it was the petitioner who masterminded the entire fraud, putting up his mother 'as a front', who executed the sale deed impersonating Maan Kaur (the actual owner of the land), with it also found that as regards the compensation received for acquisition of a part of the land, an account was fraudulently got opened in the name of Maan Kaur, and upon deposit of the compensation, it was the petitioner who withdrew money from the account.

That being so, I see no ground to entertain this petition. Consequently, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case for or against the petitioner, this petition is dismissed and the interim order earlier passed, is vacated.
