The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 101, dated 02.05.2019, under Sections 307, 323, 341, 325, 435, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station Division No.6, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of the injured. The petitioner is in custody for almost 04 months since his arrest on 14.05.2019.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Kapil Kumar states that the challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is not named in the FIR, he is in custody for

almost 04 months and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
