Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.149 dated 09.08.2010 under Sections 406, 498-A, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Phillaur, Jalandhar(Annexure P-1) and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 14.02.2019 (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated September 02, 2019, this Court had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court on 24.09.2019 to get their statements recorded, in terms of the compromise.

However, a communication dated 09.10.2019 has been received from learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phillaur, wherein it has been reported that in terms of the order dated 02.09.2019 passed by this Court, petitioners-Gurmukh Singh and Balbir Kaur had appeared before the trial Court on 24.09.2019, but the complainant-Kulwinder Kaur had not

turned up to get her statement recorded.

In view of the report so received from the Magistrate and considering the fact that the present petition was filed for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise and the complainant having not turned up before the trial Court to get her statement recorded, the present petition is dismissed.

It is made clear that in case the complainant agrees for such settlement in the case, the petitioners would be at liberty to file fresh petition for such relief as prayed in this petition.
