On 18.01.2019, on behalf of the appellant statement was made to accept ₹1,70,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Today, learned counsel and representatives of respondent No.1 – C.T.U. have placed on record a letter of the Director Transport, Chandigarh Transport Undertaking, Chandigarh, bearing Memo No.3061LO/CTU/2019 dated 28.03.2019, approving the enhancement of ₹1,70,000/- over and above the amount awarded by the MACT concerned. Thus, a sum of ₹1,70,000/- (₹ One Lac Seventy Thousand Only) is allowed to the appellant against respondent No.1 – C.T.U.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to respondent No.1 – C.T.U. to deposit a crossed – cheque for ₹1,70,000/- in the name of the appellant – Jaswinder Singh son of Sh.Balbir Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 22.05.2019, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent – C.T.U.
