Present appeal has been filed by the claimants under Section 173 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (*for short 'Act'*) against the impugned Award dated 26.09.2014, passed by learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Kurukshetra (*for short 'Tribunal'*) for enhancement of compensation on account of death of Dalbir Singh (*for short 'deceased'*).

Today, the matter has been listed before the National Lok Adalat.

Learned Counsel for respondent No.3/Insurance Company, on instructions, has offered to pay an amount of ₹ 25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand Only) over and above the compensation awarded by learned Tribunal, which is acceptable to the appellants/claimants as full and final settlement. Statements of learned Counsel for the parties to this effect have been recorded separately.

In view of the above amicable settlement between the parties, we direct respondent No.3/Insurance Company to deposit the aforesaid

enhanced amount by way of cheque or demand draft in the names of the appellants with the Office of Lok Adalat of this Court within six weeks from today and the same be handed over to them against proper receipt and identification, failing which, the amount would carry interest at the rate of 9% per annum from the date of settlement till its realization. The terms and conditions of disbursal of the aforesaid enhanced amount of compensation will remain unaltered, as passed by learned Tribunal.

FAO stands disposed off.
