The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 22.4.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 10306 of 2019. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Keeping in view the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3 to decide the pending appeal dated 13.12.2018 in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

As per order dated 22.4.2019, the respondent had to decide the appeal dated 13.12.2018 within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

As per the averments made in the petition, copy of the order passed by this Court was sent to the respondent but there is no proof attached. Let atleast now copy be supplied to the respondent and in case of doing the needful, the respondent shall ensure compliance of the order dated 22.4.2019 within four weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order. In case of non-compliance, costs may be imposed which shall be recoverable from the defaulting official.

With the aforesaid observation, the contempt petition stands disposed of.
