On 03.09.2019, the following order was passed:

" Petitioners pray for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.0069, dated 12.05.2019 registered under Sections 323, 341, 148, 149, 506 IPC and Section 307 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act added later on at Police Station Dugri District Police Commissionerate.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that injury under Section 307 IPC is not attributed to the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioners are not alleged to be armed with any weapon. He further submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Surinder Pal Singh Tinna, Additional A.G. Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions.

Adjourned to 06.09.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject

to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M-30889-2019."

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Kulwinder, has submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation, co-operated and not required for further custodial interrogation at this stage.

Hence, the order dated 03.09.2019 is made absolute.
