Petitioner-Sushil Kumar Jain has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 to 4 to enquire the matter and take legal action against respondent Nos.5 to 9.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the vehicle was purchased by him in the year 2012 and except the bald averment that the vehicle belongs to the petitioner, no material is placed on record to establish the claim. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the fact that the Registration Certificate of the vehicle is not in the name of the petitioner. It is not disputed that the vehicle was impounded in the year 2017 and this petition has been filed in the year 2019.

Since the petition is founded on disputed facts, this Court is not inclined to invoke the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C. However, it shall be open for the petitioner to avail the alternative remedy in accordance with law.
