Petitioner-Sukhvir Singh @ Sukhi has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.180 dated 28.07.2019 registered under Section 21 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 Act and Section 25 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was falsely implicated by the Police at the instance of the statement given by co-accused. According to him, the bag thrown by the petitioner contained non-commercial quantity i.e. 50 grams heroin.

It is not disputed that the petitioner is involved in similar cases registered previously and details are given in para 19 of the petition. It is mentioned that the petitioner was granted pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.58 dated 25.03.2017 whereas in the other FIR Nos.237 and 239, he was arrested

and later on released on bail vide orders dated 25.01.2017 and 30.01.2017 respectively.

Considering the above, this Court does not find any reason for grant of extra ordinary concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, petition is dismissed.
