Prayer in this petition filed under Section 407 of Cr.P.C. is for transfer of complaint under Sections 406/498-A/34/120-B/506 titled as “Manjit Kaur @ Monu Versus Mandeep Singh and others” (COMI/99/2019) dated 28.03.2019, from the court of Illaqa Magistrate, Jalandhar to Mohali.

Admittedly, the complaint has been filed by the petitioner at Jalandhar only on 28.03.2019 and no such evidence has been brought on record so as to reflect the stage of the complaint. Moreover, the marriage between the parties was solemnized on 27.01.2011. Merely because the petitioner has shifted to Mohali immediately after filing the complaint at Jalandhar, is no ground to transfer the complaint.

Accordingly, the present petition seeking transfer of complaint at Mohali, is hereby dismissed.

So far as prayer of the petitioner for grant of exemption is concerned, she is at liberty to approach the trial Court with an appropriate application seeking such exemption and the trial Court shall consider the same sympathetically.
